Stop selling and start earning! Scrip fundraising is a no-selling program that allows families to raise money for **Sandy Hook School PTA**. Scrip is just another way to pay for everyday purchases using gift cards in place of cash, checks, and credit cards.

You purchase gift cards from the PTA at face value, and our coordinator orders those cards from Great Lakes Scrip Center at a reduced price. The difference is an instant rebate for the school. It's really that simple!

When you use scrip gift cards at your favorite retailers, you're fundraising while you shop. Great Lakes Scrip Center offers over 700 of the country's biggest retailers, including grocery, department stores, gas stations, restaurants, hotels, home improvement, and more. Just by using scrip to pay for your normal weekly purchases, you can easily raise \$500 or more per year. ***It's time to put your shopping dollars to work! How Your Earnings Get to SHS PTA:

Money can flow between our program, families, and Great Lakes Scrip Center in a few different ways.


If families pay by check, the PTA will collect that check from the family for the full-face value, and then pay GLSC the reduced net amount. This way, the PTA receives the rebate as soon as we place our order with GLSC.

If families pay with PrestoPay, the secure online payment, system, the process works a little differently:

- When families order physical cards, their PrestoPay payment will be reflected in the PTA's purchase order. The family pays the full-face value directly to GLSC through PrestoPay, and the PTA order total is reduced by the amount of their payment. This way, Sandy Hook School receives the value of the rebate as soon as we submit our purchase order.
- When families place auto orders for ScripNow, Reload, or ReloadNow, their PrestoPay payment goes directly to GLSC. For auto orders, GLSC tracks all the rebates earned by families and then makes one weekly deposit into our PTA's bank account.

Here's an example: One of our families orders one \$100 Amazon.com gift card with a 3% rebate.

- **If they pay by check for physical cards or online products**, they will write the PTA a \$100 check, and we will pay GLSC \$97.



- If they pay for a physical card with PrestoPay, the PTA pays \$97 for the card, and our organization order total is reduced by the family's \$100 payment.



- **If they pay for ScripNow, Reload, or ReloadNow with PrestoPay**, their \$100 payment will come directly to GLSC, and the \$3 rebate will be included in the weekly deposit made to the PTA's account.
